He is the founder and Managing Partner of **æquitas consultoría**, where he has developed a model based on applied legal intelligence: clear risk identification, strategic structuring of decisions, and execution supported by solid technical grounding. His work focuses on advising companies and decision-makers in high-complexity matters, particularly tax audits, controversies, corporate restructurings, and the validation of third-party strategies.

Throughout his career, he has advised national and multinational companies, financial institutions, and public entities, participating in high-impact projects involving significant financial and regulatory exposure. His experience includes serving as a partner at Andersen Tax & Legal in Mexico, as well as a senior associate at international firms such as Baker & McKenzie and Basham, Ringe y Correa, and holding senior in-house legal positions within major business groups.

Landmark case

In 2019-2020, he led the constitutional challenges against the appointment of the head of PRODECON (Taxpayer Ombudsman), resulting in rulings that forced reconsideration of the selection process and contributed to the position being filled by a technically qualified specialist. This is the only successful case of its kind.
